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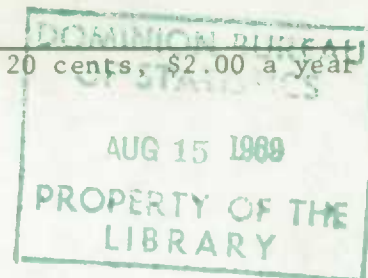
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## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

August 1969

Source and Content



Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments.

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## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

August 1, 1969

### Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of August 1969, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 77,808,000 lb. Cold storage warehouses had in store 49,132,000 lb. while dairy factories held 28,676,000 lb. The summary total was higher than last year by 21.3 million pounds. The five-year average 1964-68 of August 1 stocks is 84,750,000 lb. The July 1969 "in-to-storage" movement was 13.4 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 13.2 million pounds last year.

### Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 89,332,000 lb. Canadian. The summary total was lower than last year by 3.2 million pounds and showed an "in-to-storage" movement of 10.4 million pounds for July 1969.

### Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 38,947,000 lb. which was a decrease of 6.9 million pounds from last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for July 1969 was 0.9 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 206,990,000 lb. a decrease of 11.5 million pounds from last year and an increase of 10.8 million pounds over last month.

### Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at August 1, 1969 totalled 5,217,000 lb. being 3.5 million pounds lower than the 1968 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for July 1969 was 820 thousand pounds as compared with a similar movement of 498 thousand pounds during July 1968.

### Poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated poultry meat stocks at August 1, 1969 was lower than last year by 457 thousand pounds. An "in-to-storage" movement of 1.3 million pounds is shown for the month of July 1969. By kind, the stocks were: Chicken, 12,603,000 lb., Fowl, 2,585,000 lb., Turkey, 22,246,000 lb., Duck, 780,000 lb. and Goose, 25,000 lb.
