

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

September 1969 Source and Content



Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments.

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

September 1, 1969

Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of September 1969, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 92,930,000 lb. Cold storage warehouses had in store 58,016,000 lb. while dairy factories held 34,914,000 lb. The summary total was higher than last year by 24.5 million pounds. The five-year average 1964-68 of September 1 stocks is 93,476,000 lb. The August 1969 "in-to-storage" movement was 13.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 11.9 million pounds last year.

Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 90,421,000 lb. Canadian. The summary total was lower than last year by 8.7 million pounds and showed an "in-to-storage" movement of 1.5 million pounds for August 1969.

Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 51,460,000 lb. which was an increase of 2.4 million pounds over last year. The "in-to-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for August 1969 was 5.1 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 207,001,000 lb. a decrease of 34.7 million pounds from last year and a decrease of 2.2 million pounds from last month.

Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at September 1, 1969 totalled 5,462,000 lb. being 3.2 million pounds lower than the 1968 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for August 1969 was 246 thousand pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 49 thousand pounds during August 1968.

Poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated poultry meat stocks at September 1, 1969 was higher than last year by 2.1 million pounds. An "in-to-storage" movement of 13.0 million pounds is shown for the month of August 1969. By kind, the stocks were: Chicken, 12,864,000 lb., Fowl, 3,740,000 lb., Turkey, 33,591,000 lb., Duck, 976,000 lb. and Goose, 24,000 lb.
