

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

July 1970

Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments.

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS

July 1, 1970

Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of July 1970, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 89,498,000 lb. The summary total was higher than last year by 24.6 million pounds. The five-year average 1965-1969 of July 1 stocks is 58,982,000 lb. The June 1970 "in-to-storage" movement was 13.8 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 19.6 million pounds last year.

Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 66,385,000 lb. Canadian. The summary total was lower than last year by 13.1 million pounds and showed an "in-to-storage" movement of 5.7 million pounds for June 1970.

Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 26,744,000 lb. which was a decrease of 13.1 million pounds from last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for June 1970 was 1.9 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 106,565,000 lb. a decrease of 91.8 million pounds from last year and an increase of 12.5 million pounds over last month.

Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at July 1, 1970 totalled 5,747,000 lb. being 1.3 million pounds higher than the 1969 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for June 1970 was 1.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 909 thousand pounds during June 1969.

Poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated poultry meat stocks at July 1, 1970 was higher than last year by 5.0 million pounds. An "out-of-storage" movement of 241 thousand pounds is shown for the month of June 1970. By kind, the stocks were: Chicken, 21,249,000 lb., Fowl, 3,472,000 lb., Turkey, 15,681,000 lb., Duck, 907,000 lb. and Goose, 183,000 lb.
