

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

NOVEMBER 1, 1971

Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, growers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments; while stocks of poultry products are obtained with the co-operation of the Canada Department of Agriculture.



STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

November 1, 1971

Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of November 1971, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 68,841,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 48.7 million pounds. The five-year average 1966-1970 of November 1 stocks is 92,664,000 lb. The October 1971 "out-of-storage" movement was 4.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 863 thousand pounds last year.

Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 65,283,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 2.6 million pounds and showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 3.1 million pounds for October 1971.

Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 43,644,000 lb. which was an increase of 3.7 million pounds over last year. The "in-to-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for October 1971 was 6.1 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 67,467,000 lb. a decrease of 88.5 million pounds from last year and a decrease of 1.9 million pounds from last month.

Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at November 1, 1971 totalled 12,543,000 lb. being 4.5 million pounds higher than the 1970 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for October 1971 was 375 thousand pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 4 thousand pounds during October 1970.

Frozen poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated frozen poultry meat stocks at November 1, 1971 was lower than last year by 1.8 million pounds. An "in-to-storage" movement of 2.6 million pounds is shown for the month of October 1971. By kind, the frozen stocks were: Chicken, 16,651,000 lb., Fowl, 5,786,000 lb., Turkey, 66,577,000 lb., Duck, 1,437,000 lb. and Goose, 210,000 lb.
