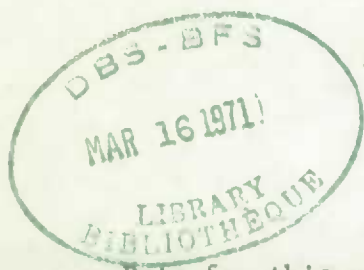

## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

March 1, 1971

### Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, growers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments; while stocks of poultry products are obtained with the co-operation of the Canada Department of Agriculture.

Beginning September 1, 1970, the data in this publication has reference to frozen poultry products only. Previously, fresh and frozen poultry products were reported and published in total only. Therefore, current stocks of poultry products are no longer comparable to those reported prior to September 1, 1970.

## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

March 1, 1971

### Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of March 1971, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 65,953,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 7.8 million pounds. The five-year average 1966-1970 of March 1 stocks is 45,211,000 lb. The February 1971 "out-of-storage" movement was 15.9 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 9.6 million pounds last year.

### Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 54,150,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 22.4 million pounds and showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 2.7 million pounds for February 1971.

### Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 13,133,000 lb. which was a decrease of 14.4 million pounds from last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for February 1971 was 12.4 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 58,513,000 lb. a decrease of 58.9 million pounds from last year and a decrease of 15.3 million pounds from last month.

### Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at March 1, 1971 totalled 7,140,000 lb. being 3.9 million pounds higher than the 1970 figures. The "out-of-storage" movement for February 1971 was 420 thousand pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 158 thousand pounds during February 1970.

### Frozen poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated frozen poultry meat stocks at March 1, 1971 was higher than last year by 17.8 million pounds. An "out-of-storage" movement of 697 thousand pounds is shown for the month of February 1971. By kind, the frozen stocks were: Chicken, 28,799,000 lb., Fowl, 5,729,000 lb., Turkey, 32,416,000 lb., Duck, 572,000 lb. and Goose, 271,000 lb. Changes in stocks are subject to the incomparability of the data, reference paragraph 4, Page 1.
