## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

September 1, 1971

Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, growers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments; while stocks of poultry products are obtained with the co-operation of the Canada Department of Agriculture.

Beginning September 1, 1970, the data in this publication has reference to frozen poultry products only. Previously, fresh and frozen poultry products were reported and published in total only. Therefore, current stocks of poultry products are no longer comparable to those reported prior to September 1, 1970.

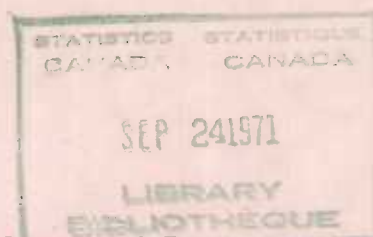

## STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

September 1, 1971

### Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of September 1971, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 73,051,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 43.1 million pounds. The five-year average 1966-1970 of September 1 stocks is 87,221,000 lb. The August 1971 "in-to-storage" movement was 2.9 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 9.8 million pounds last year.

### Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 60,904,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 13.8 million pounds and showed an "in-to-storage" movement of 1.9 million pounds for August 1971.

### Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 34,589,000 lb. which was a decrease of 6.8 million pounds over last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for August 1971 was 6.4 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 89,524,000 lb. a decrease of 66.5 million pounds from last year and an increase of 8.6 million pounds over last month.

### Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at September 1, 1971 totalled 11,468,000 lb. being 3.9 million pounds higher than the 1970 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for August 1971 was 447 thousand pounds as compared with a similar movement of 690 thousand pounds during August 1970.

### Frozen poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated frozen poultry meat stocks at September 1, 1971 was higher than last year by 17.0 million pounds. An "in-to-storage" movement of 12.0 million pounds is shown for the month of August 1971. By kind, the frozen stocks were: Chicken, 18,686,000 lb., Fowl, 6,368,000 lb., Turkey 46,969,000 lb., Duck, 1,173,000 lb. and Goose, 178,000 lb. Changes in stocks are subject to the incomparability of the data, reference paragraph 4, Page 1.
