STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

April 1, 1972

Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, growers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments; while stocks of poultry products are obtained with the co-operation of the Canada Department of Agriculture.

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

April 1, 1972

Creamery butter

Due to a strike in the province of Quebec, affecting provincial government offices, inventory data for that province and consequently Canada totals are not available at this time.

Cheddar cheese

Due to a strike in the province of Quebec, affecting provincial government offices, inventory data for that province and consequently Canada totals are not available at this time.

Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 20,090,000 lb. which was an increase of 11.7 million pounds over last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for March 1972 was 2.8 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 30,689,000 lb. an increase of 21 thousand pounds over last year and an increase of 1.2 million pounds over last month.

Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at April 1, 1972 totalled 13,660,000 lb. being 5.5 million pounds higher than the 1971 figures. The "in-to-storage" movement for March 1972 was 26 thousand pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.0 million pounds during March 1971.

Frozen poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated frozen poultry meat stocks at April 1, 1972 was lower than last year by 20.1 million pounds. An "out-of-storage" movement of 10.6 million pounds is shown for the month of March 1972. By kind, the frozen stocks were: Chicken, 16,802,000 lb., Fowl, 4,662,000 lb., Turkey, 20,970,000 lb., Duck, 756,000 lb. and Goose, 72,000 lb.




