STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS

JUNE 1, 1972

Source and Content

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, growers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments; while stocks of poultry products are obtained with the co-operation of the Canada Department of Agriculture.

STOCKS OF DAIRY AND FROZEN POULTRY PRODUCTS  
JUNE 1, 1972

### Creamery butter

At the opening of the first business day of June 1972, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 29,615,000 lb. The summary total was lower than last year by 21.5 million pounds. The five-year average 1967-1971 of June 1 stocks is 46,223,000 lb. The May 1972 "in-to-storage" movement was 7.4 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.9 million pounds last year.

### Cheddar cheese

The total stocks of cheddar cheese were 61,412,000 lb. The summary total was higher than last year by 12.9 million pounds and showed an "in-to-storage" movement of 600 thousand pounds for May 1972.

### Concentrated milk products

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 22,612,000 lb. which was an increase of 2.7 million pounds over last year. The "in-to-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for May 1972 was 9.9 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-product, skim milk powder, amounted to 63,058,000 lb. an increase of 13.7 million pounds over last year and an increase of 20.8 million pounds over last month.

### Frozen eggs

Stocks of frozen eggs at June 1, 1972 totalled 11,831,000 lb. being 527 thousand pounds higher than the 1971 figures. The "out-of-storage" movement for May 1972 was 875 thousand pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 1.8 million pounds during May 1971.

### Frozen poultry meat

The summary total of dressed and eviscerated frozen poultry meat stocks at June 1, 1972 was lower than last year by 18.0 million pounds. An "out-of-storage" movement of 4.8 million pounds is shown for the month of May 1972. By kind, the frozen stocks were: Chicken, 17,595,000 lb., Fowl, 3,854,000 lb., Turkey, 16,133,000 lb., Duck, 812,000 lb. and Goose, 61,000 lb.


