COLD STORIGE STOCKS OF SPPIES IND SMATI FRUITS, OCTOBER I, 1936.
apples held in cold storage establishments and in fruit storages employing refrigeration equipment at October 1, 1936, amounted to 12,867 barre1s, 436,857 boxes or hampers and 3,867 crates and baskets. Compared with October 1, 1935 these figures show a decrease of approximately 24 thousand barrels but an increase of approximately 254 thousand boxes and hampers, and an increase of approximately 2 thousand crates and baskets. Converting barrels to boxes, it shows a net increase of 182 thousand boxes. This advance in apple holdings is partly accounjed for by the addition of 45 new firss added to the list during the yoar. Betreen September I and October 1, 1936, there were increases of approximately 12 thousand barrels, 417 thousand boxes and hampers and about 2 thousand crates.

On October 1, 1930́, 626,903 quarts of $x=0$ enen stra:berries were reportod. Comparing these holdings mith those shown at Octobe: I, 1935, an increase of approximately 63 thousand quaris or 11.1 per cent is jindicatod. Betmeen September 1 and October 1, 1936, frozen stocks show an increase of approx mately 22 thousand quarts or 3.7 per cent. Frozen raspberries amounted to 265,814 cuarts, which represents a decrease of nearly 30 thousand quarts or 10.1 per cent corpared with the stocks reported at the same date a yea ago, but an increase of approximately 7 thousand quarts over the holdings reported at the first of the previous month,
