## COLD STORAGE STOCKS OF APPLES AND SMALL FRUITS, JULY 1, 1936.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in fruit storages employing refrigeration equipment, amounted to 520 barrels and 27,750 boxes or hampers. Decreases amounting to 191 barrels and nearly 21 thousand boxes and hampers are recorded between July 1, 1935 and July 1, 1936. These changes in holdings are partly accounted for by 30 new firms added to the list during the year. Between June 1, and July 1, 1936, there was a decrease of about 3 thousand barrels and approximately 54 thousand boxes or hampers.

On July 1, 1936, 10,781 quarts of fresh strawberries and 472,330 quarts of frozen strawberries were reported, making decreases of 83 thousand quarts of fresh stocks and 19 thousand quarts of frozen stocks from the same date of the previous year. Between June 1 and July 1, 1936, increases of approximately 11 thousand and 109 thousand quarts respectively were recorded. Raspberry holdings were reported as 686 quarts of fresh and 85,364 quarts of frozen fruit at July 1, 1936, representing decreases of approximately 12 thousand and 17 thousand quarts, respectively, from July 1, 1935. Between June 1 and July 1, 1936, frozen stocks declined about 40 thousand quarts.
