## COLD STORAGE STOEKS OF APPLES AND SMALL FRUITS, AUGUST 1, 1936.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in fruit storages employing refrigeration equipment amountel to 86 barrels and 7,901 boxes or hampers. Increases amounting to 28 barrels and neacly $6 \frac{3}{2}$ thousand boxes and hampers were reported between August 1, 1935 and August 1, 2936. These changes in holdings are partiy accounted for by 30 new firms added to the list during the year. Between July 1, and August 1, 1936, there was a decrease of about 434 barrels and approximately 18 thousand boxes or hampers.

On August 1, $1936,3,393$ quarts of fresh strawberries and 541,228 quarts of frozen strawberries were reported, making an increase of 277 quarts of fresh stocks and a decrease of 459 thousand quarts of frozen stocks from the same date of the previous year. Between July 1 and August 1, 1936, a decrease of 7 thousand quarts of fresh strawberries and an increase of nearly 69 thousand quarts of frozen fruit were reoorded. Raspberry holdings were reported as 5,020 quarts of fresh and 236,610 quarts of frozen fruit at August 1, 1936, representing decreases of 4 thousand quarts and 43 thousand quarts, respectively, from August 2, 1935. Between July 2 and August 1, 1936, frozen stocks increased 151 thousand quarts.
