COLD STORAGE STOCKS OF APPLES AND SMALL FRUITS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1936.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in fruit storages employing refrigeration equipment, amounted to 377 barrels and 16,623 boxes or hampers. At September 1, 1936 there was a decrease in barrel stocks but was an increase in boxed apples amounting to 130 barrels and 11,450 boxes, compared with the stock reported at the same date in 1935. Converting the barrels to boxes it shows a net increase of 11,060 boxes. This advance in apple holdings is partly accounted for by the addition 15 new firms added to the list during the year. Between August 1 and September 1, 1936, there was an increase of about 291 barrels and approximately 8,700 boxes or hampers.


On September 1, 1936, 4,635 quarts of fresh strawberries and 579,365 quarts of frozen strawberried were reported, making an increase of 3,959 quarts of fresh stocks and a decrease of approximately 276 thousand quarts of frozen stocks from the same date of the previous year. Between August 1 and September 1, 1936, a decrease of approximately 800 quarts of fresh strawberries and an increase of nearly 38 thousand quarts of freen fruit were recorded. Raspberry holdings were reported as 522 quarts of fresh and 258,698 quarts of frozen fruit at September 1, 1936.

Comparing the frozen holdings with those reported at the same date last year a decrease of 62,059 quarts are recorded and compared with the stocks reported at the first of the previous month there is an increase of 22,088 quarts. SEPTEMBER 1, 1936. APPLES IN COLD STORAGES IN CANADA, BY PROVINCES,
