STOCKS OF CANADIAN TREE FRUITS, SMALL FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, OCTOBER 1, 1937.

Apples held in Cold and Common Storage at October 1, 1937 amounted to 28,896 barrels, 583,851 boxes, and 85,350 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures show an increase of approximately 718 thousand bushels from September 1, 1937, with 111 firms reporting as against 93 last month. Compared with October 1, 1936, the combined figures show an increase of approximately 73 thousand bushels, with 111 firms reporting as against 123 at this time last year.

Stocks of Pears in Cold and Common Storage at October 1, 1937 amounted to 77,484 bushels as against 37,065 at September 1, 1937 and 77,799 at October 1, 1936.

Stocks of small fruit, fresh and frozen, may be partially summarized as follows, the figures at the first of last month appearing in brackets: Raspberries: 11,518 crates (9,486); 5,743 pints (18,255); 1,678 barrels (1,776); 110 pails (76); 159,709 pounds (438,954). Strawberries: 4,093 crates (3,117) 15,399 pints (2,609) 5,049 barrels (4,366); 2,442 pails (1,187); 622,968 pounds (1,057,810). Cherries: 468 barrels (465); 5,345 pails (5,259); 217,989 pounds (313,971). Blueberries: 5,731 crates (11,223); 52,246 quarts (66,210); 927,667 pounds (1,170,638).

Vegetables held in Cold and Common Storage as at October 1, 1937 are reported by provinces, with comparative data for September 1, 1937. The holdings of potatoes amounted to 7,552 cwt. at October 1, 1937, compared with 11,173 cwt. a month ago, representing a decrease of 3,621 cwt. Onion stocks reached a total of 9,467 cwt. at October 1, 1937, in comparison with 2,662 cwt. at the first of the previous month, showing an increase of 6,805 cwt. Celery amounted to 79,506 crates at October 1, 1937 as compared with 1,497 crates at September 1, 1937, showing an increase of 78,009 crates.
