
## STOCKS OF APPLES, PEARS, SMALL FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, FEBRUARY 1,1937.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in fruit storages at February 1, 1937 amounted to 67,281 barrels, 372,950 boxes, 146,252 hampers, 18,906 bushels and 14,828 crates. Compared with the holdings at February 1, 1936, these figures show decreases of approximately 1 thousand barrels and 238 thousand boxes and increases of approximately 43 thousand hampers and 5 thousand crates. Converting barrels to boxes the figures reported show a decrease of approximately 242 thousand boxes from February 1, 1936 and a decrease of 305 thousand boxes from the same date last month. Compared with January 1, 1937 the data reveal decreases of approximately 36 thousand barrels, 198 thousand boxes, 53 thousand hampers, 6 thousand bushels, and 12 thousand crates. 16 firms holding apples in storage are listed as outstanding.


