### STOCKS OF APPLES, PEARS, SMALL FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, APRIL 1, 1937.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in sales warehouses at April 1, 1937 amounted to 25,597 barrels, 98,672 boxes, 38,560 hampers, 6,201 bushels and 6,526 crates. Compared with the holdings at April 1, 1936, these figures show decreases of approximately 200 barrels; 118 thousand boxes; and 34 thousand hampers; and increases of approximately 4 thousand crates. Compared with the holdings at March 1, 1937 the data reveal decreases of approximately 23 thousand barrels; 133 thousand boxes; 45 thousand hampers; 6 thousand crates; and an increase of approximately 2,000 bushels. Converting barrels to boxes the combined figures show decreases of approximately 118 thousand boxes from April 1, 1936 and 140 thousand boxes from the same date last month. Out of a total of 182 apple reporting firms 28 failed to report at April 1. It is believed, however, that many of these had nothing in storage.

Stocks of frozen fruit held under refrigeration at April 1, 1937 are shown in Table III, the contents of which may be partially summarized as follows, the figures at the first of last month appearing in brackets: Raspberries: 1,585 crates (1,908); 21,924 pints (26,725); 506 barrels (703) and 91,911 pounds (142,831). Strawberries: 4,151 crates (4,926); 17,322 quarts (34,140); 2,592 pints (3,798); 986 pails (178); 242 barrels (336); 274,832 pounds (484,546). Cherries: 111 barrels (130); 2,253 pails (3,676); 169,842 pounds (212,373). Blueberries: 280 crates (259); 25,239 quarts (27,995); 45,898 pounds (59,287).

Vegetables held in cold storages and sales warehouses (stocks in refrigerated and ordinary rooms combined) as at April 1, 1937 are reported in Table V by provinces, with comparative data for March 1, 1937. The holdings of potatoes amounted to 100,734 hundredweights at April 1, 1937 compared with 84,097 hundredweights a month ago representing an increase of 16,637 hundredweights. Onion stocks reached a total of 37,805 hundredweights at April 1, 1937 in comparison with 32,752 hundredweights at the first of the previous month, showing an increase of 5,053 hundredweights. Celery holdings amounted to 1,442 crates at April 1, 1937 as against 8,376 hundredweights at March 1, 1937 which represents a decrease of 6,934 crates.
