STOCKS OF APPLES, PEARS, SMALL FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, MAY 1, 1937.

Apples held in cold storage establishments and in sales warehouses at May 1, 1937 amounted to 11,307 barrels, 44,755 boxes, 18,569 hampers, and 2,444 crates. Compared with holdings at April 1, 1937 these figures show decreases of approximately 22 thousand barrels; 76 thousand boxes; 24 thousand hampers; 5 thousand crates. Converting barrels to boxes the combined figures show decreases of approximately 142 thousand boxes from April 1, 1937. Out of a total of 182 apple reporting firms 35 failed to report at May 1. It is believed, however, that many of these had nothing in storage.

Stocks of frozen fruit held under refrigeration at May 1, 1937 are shown in Table III, the contents of which may be partially summarized as follows, the figures at the first of last month appearing in brackets: Raspberries: 1,188 crates (1,585½); 18,301 pints (21,924); 395 barrels (638½); and 84,579 pounds (91,911). Strawberries: 3,798½ crates (4,151); 203 quarts (17,3); 503 barrels (477); 107,536 pounds (274,832). Cherries: 47 barrels (113); 3,311 pails (2,253); 129,363 pounds (169,842). Blueberries: 49 crates (280); 11,995 quarts (25,239); 33,716 pounds (45,898); Vegetables held in cold storages and sales warehouses (stocks in refrigerated and ordinary rooms combined) as at May 1, 1937 are reported in Table V, by provinces, with comparative data for April 1, 1937. The holdings of potatoes amounted to 84,932 hundredweights at May 1, 1937, compared with 107,281 hundredweights a month ago representing a decrease of 22,349 hundredweights. Onion stocks reached a total of 24,493 hundredweights at May 1, 1937 in comparison with 37,439 hundredweights at the first of the previous month, showing a decrease of 12,941 hundredweights. Celery holdings amounted to 4,850 crates at May 1, 1937 as against 2,412 crates at April 1, 1937 which represents an increase of 2,438 crates.




