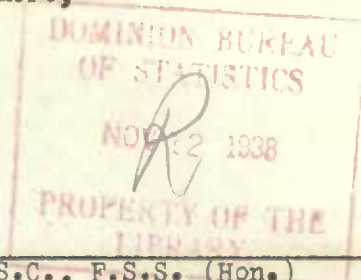

STOCKS OF CANADIAN FRUIT, AND VEGETABLES, NOVEMBER 1, 1938.

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage including storage by commercial growers, are compiled by provinces and by principal cities. At November 1, 1938 in Canada there were 1,576,158 barrels, 2,810,392 boxes and 662,493 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures are 8,201,359 bushels, compared with 1,786,355 bushels at October 1, 1938, the latter at distributing points only, this being an increase of 6.4 million bushels.

Canadian pears reached a total of 66,332 bushels compared with 116,402 bushels at October 1, 1938, a decrease of 50 thousand bushels.

Stocks of frozen fruit are shown as straight frozen, two parts fruit to one part sugar, three parts fruit to one part sugar, and pulp. Fruit in sulphur dioxide is shown separately. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement for all frozen and SO₂ fruit as reported, is 2.8 million lb.

Canadian-grown vegetables held in Cold and Common Storage including storage by commercial growers, are reported by provinces. At November 1, 1938, the holdings of potatoes amounted to 261,991 tons, compared with 25,339 tons at October 1, 1938, the latter at distributing points only, this being an increase of 236 thousand tons. Onion stocks reached a total of 14,350 tons as compared with 4,898 at the first of last month, the latter at distributing points, only, showing an increase of 9 thousand tons.

Canadian celery amounted to 242,905 crates, compared with 94,459 at October 1, 1938, showing an increase of 148 thousand crates.
