## STOCKS OF CHNADIAN FRUIT, AND VEGETABLFS, AFRIL 1, 1938.

Apples held in Cold and Cormon Storage, including storage by commercial growers, are compiled ry provinces and by principal cities. At April 1, 1938 in Canada there were 56,445 barrels, 401,370 boxes, and 147,476 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures are 718,181 bushels, compared with $1,422,120$ bushels at liarch 1, 1938, which represents a decrease of approximately 704 thousand bushels.

Stocks of frozen fruit are shown as: straight frozen, two parts fruit to one part sugar, three parts fruit to one part sugar, and pulp. Fruit in sulphur dioxide is shown separately. The net "Out-of-Storage" movement, shown for all frozen and $\mathrm{SO}_{2}$ fruit as reported, is $810,979 \mathrm{lb}$., but revised figures for firms that failed to report in time will reduce these figures.

Vegetables held in Cold and Conmon Storage, including storage by commercial growers, ere reported by provinces. At april l, 1938, the holdings of potatoes, in Canada, amounted to 71,922 tons, comparea with 106,389 tons at March 1, 1938, which represents a decrease of 34,467 tons. Onion stocks reached a total of 282 tons as compared with 1,132 at the first of last month, showing a decrease of 851 tons.
