## STOCKS OF CANADIAN FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, JUNE 1, 1942

#### APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, including stocks held by commercial growers, were 386 barrels, 24,245 boxes and 3,717 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 29,120 bushels as compared with 383,278 bushels at June 1, 1941, and 96,759 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 67.6 thousand bushels. In addition there were stocks of Imported apples amounting to 23,894 bushels.

#### PEARS

There were only 6 bushels of Imported pears on hand.

### FROZEN AND SO2 FRUIT

Frozen fruit stocks are shown as straight frozen, two parts fruit to one part sugar, three parts fruit to one part sugar, and as pulp. The total was 2,835,133 lb. (including an estimate of 100 thousand lb. for firms failing to report) as compared with 3.9 million lb. last year and 3.5 million lb. last month.

Fruit in SO2 totalled 5,249,955 lb. including an estimate of 1.3 million lb. for firms failing to report on time.

Frozen and SO2 fruit combined were 8,085,088 lb. including the estimate. The combined figures last year at the same date were 7,472,333 lb. Including the estimate there was an apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.6 million 1b. during May 1942. During May 1941 there was a similar movement of 2.3 millioh lb.

#### VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables, including those held by commercial growers, were as follows:-

Potato holdings amounted to 11,003 tons, a decrease from last month of 33.5 thousand tons as compared with a decrease of 29.6 thousand tons last year. There were also 231 tons of Imported potatoes on hand.

Onion stocks were reported as 202 tons, as compared with 940 tons at the same date last year, and 881 tons on May 1, 1942. In addition there were 1,144. tons of Imported Onions.

Celery. There were 9,363 crates of Imported Celery in stock.

## FROZEN VEGETABLES

There were 367,038 lb. Peas; 94,875 lb. String Beans and 433,580 lb. Other Vegetables on hand. No separation is made of retail and

wholesale containers.

There were decreases from last month's revised figures of 61.8 thousand pounds Peas, 23.2 thousand 1b. String Beans, and 84.8 thousand pounds Other Vegetables.


