STOCKS OF CANADIAN FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, JULY 1, 1943APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, at Distributing Centres only, were 168 barrels, 27,284 boxes and 1,250 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 29,038 bushels as compared with 7,054 bushels at July 1, 1942 and 120,826 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 91.8 thousand bushels. The Imported stocks amounted to 1,653 bushels.

PEARS

There were only 71 bushels imported pears on hand.

FROZEN AND SO<sub>2</sub> FRUIT

Frozen fruit stocks are shown as straight frozen, two parts fruit to one part sugar, three parts fruit to one part sugar, and as pulp. The total was 4,211,929 lb. (including an estimate of 300 thousand lb.) as compared with 6.9 million lb. last year and 3.6 million lb. last month.

Fruit in SO<sub>2</sub> totalled 7,035,666 lb. including an estimate of 970 thousand lb. for firms failing to report on time.

Frozen and SO<sub>2</sub> fruit combined were 11,247,595 lb. including the estimate. The combined figures last year at the same date were 14,055,130 lb. Including the estimate there was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 609 thousand lb. during June 1943. During June 1942 there was a similar movement of 5.8 million lb.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables at Distributing Centres only, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 3,780 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 21.1 thousand tons, as compared with a similar movement of 7.2 thousand tons last year. There were also 106 tons of Imported potatoes on hand.

Onions stocks were reported as 97 tons, as compared with 117 tons at the same date last year, and 1,353 tons on June 1, 1943.

Celery. There were 694 crates of Canadian Celery and 1,099 crates of Imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 14 tons; Cabbage 90 tons; Carrots 376 tons; Parsnips 41 tons. In addition to these Canadian stocks there were Imported holdings of 62 tons Beets, 58 tons Cabbages and 777 tons Carrots.

FROZEN VEGETABLES

Frozen Vegetables totalled 492,145 lb. being Peas 104,057 lb., String Beans 16,501 lb. and Other Vegetables 371,587 lb. No separation is made of retail and wholesale containers.

The total on the corresponding date last year was 950,036 lb. There was an increase over last month of 202 thousand lb.
