### STOCKS OF CANADIAN FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, AUGUST 1, 1943

#### APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, at Distributing Centres only, were 105 barrels, 5,327 boxes and 539 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 6,165 bushels as compared with 5,888 bushels at August 1, 1942 and 29,038 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 22,9 thousand bushels. The Imported stocks amounted to 1,882 bushels.

#### PEARS

There were 3,369 bushels Imported pears on hand.

#### FROZEN AND SO<sub>2</sub> FRUIT

Frozen fruit stocks are shown as straight frozen, two parts fruit to one part sugar, three parts fruit to one part sugar, and as pulp. The total was 7,743,281 lb. (including an estimate of 340 thousand lb.) as compared with 10.7 million lb. last year and 4.2 million lb. last month.

Fruit in SO<sub>2</sub> totalled 10,615,464 lb. including an estimate of 1.1 million lb. for firms failing to report on time.

Frozen and SO<sub>2</sub> fruit combined were 18,358,745 lb. including the estimate. The combined figures last year at the same date were 23,267,323 lb. Including the estimate there was an apparent net "Into-Storage" movement of 6.9 million lb. during July 1943. During July 1942 there was a similar movement of 9.2 million lb.

#### VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables at Distributing Centres only, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 1,553 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 2.2 thousand tons, as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 thousand tons last year. There were also 471 tons of Imported potatoes on hand.

Onions stocks were reported as 202 tons, as compared with 433 tons at the same date last year, and 97 tons on July 1, 1943.

Celery. There were 2,132 crates of Canadian Celery and 12 crates of Imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 49 tons; Cabbage 166 tons; Carrots 141 tons; Parsnips 26 tons. In addition to these Canadian stocks there were Imported holdings of 30 tons Beets, 1 ton Cabbages and 288 tons Carrots.

#### FROZEN VEGETABLES

Frozen Vegetables totalled 1,019,083 lb. being Peas 839,766 lb., String Beans 7,974 lb. and Other Vegetables 171,343 lb. The total on the corresponding date last year was 2,133,000 lb. There was an increase over last month of 527 thousand lb.
