#### STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, MARCH 1, 1944

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, including holdings in the hands of commercial grewers, were 94,063 barrels, 657,254 boxes and 238,737 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 1,178,160 bushels as compared with 1,777,331 bushels at March 1, 1945 and 2,608,399 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.4 million bushels,

PEARS

There were 33 bushels Canadian pears in storage,

There were 791.773 lb. fruit in Consumer Packages (including an estimate of 7,000 lbs.) as compared with 694,436 lb. last month, while for re-processing purposes the total of all frozen fruits was 10,165,941 lb. including an estimate of 350 thousand lb. As imported fr its, including ci rus 'ruits, are now included a comparison cannot be made with previous years, but the total for last month was 9,685,592 lb.

FRUIT IN PRESERVATIVES The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 16,963,524 lb. (including an estimate of 1.7 million lb.) as compared with 18.9 million lb. last month,

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables including stocks in the hands of commercial growers, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 183,922 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 30 thousand tons, as compared with a similar movement of 32 thousand tons last year.

Onion stocks were reported as 1,733 tons, as compared with 9,604 tons at the same date last year, and 3,316 tons on February 1, 1944.

Celery. There were 4,152 crates of Canadian Celery and 14,321 crates of imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 615 tons; Cabbage 1,080 tons; Carrots 5,202 tons and Parsnips 412 tons. In addition there were 135 tons of imported Beets, 414 tons Cabbage; 42 tons Carrots; 1 ton Onions and 82 tons Potatoes.

FROZEN VEGETABLES

The new Consumer Packages classification showed a total of 1,048,246 lb. There were also 243,780 lb. for Re-processing purposes. Included in this amount were 50,000 lb. as an estimate.

VEGETABLES IN BRINE

There were 656,943 lb. vegetables held in brine for Re-processing purposes,
