STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, MAY 1, 1944

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, including holdings in the hands of commercial growers, were 11,243 barrels, 150,467 boxes and 39,430 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 223,626 bushels as compared with 323,817 bushels at May 1, 1943 and 621,611 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 398 thousand bushels. In addition there were 550 bushels of imported apples on hand.

PEARS

There were no pears reported in storage.

There were 689,425 lb. fruit in Consumer Packages (including an estimate of 25,000 lb.) as compared with 520,159 lb. last month, while for re-processing purposes the total of all frozen fruits was 8,842,373 lb. including an estimate of 1.3 million lb. As imported fruits, including citrus fruits, are now included a comparison cannot be made with previous years, but the total for last month was 10,712,426 lb.

FRUIT IN PRESERVATIVES The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 15,554,522 lb. (including an estimate of 7.0 million lb.) as compared with 17 million lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables including stocks in the hands of commercial growers, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 104,242 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 33 thousand tons, as compared with a similar movement of 34 thousand tons last year.

Onion stocks were reported as 147 tons, as compared with 4,806 tons at the same date last year, and 838 tons on April 1, 1944.

Celery. There were 271 crates of Canadian Celery and 11,911 crates of imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 154 tons; Cabbage 70 tons; Carrots 1,690 tons and Parsnips 163 tons. In addition there were 158 tons of imported Beets, 376 tons Cabbage; 443 tons Carrots and 69 tons Onions.

FROZEN VEGETABLES

The new Consumer Packages classification showed a total of 568,410 lb. There were also 197,639 lb. for Re-processing purposes.

<u>VEGETABLES IN BRINE</u> There were 226,920 lb. vegetables held in brine for Re-processing purposes.
