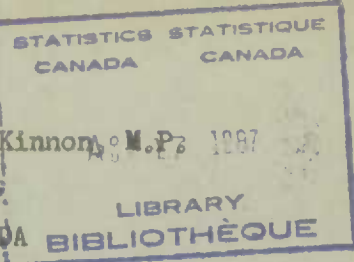

#### STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, AUGUST 1, 1944

##### APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, at distributing centres only, were 413 barrels, 7,166 boxes and 935 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 9,340 bushels as compared with 6,165 bushels at August 1, 1943 and 10,081 bushels last month.

##### PEARS

There were 1,749 bushels of imported pears.

##### FROZEN FRUIT

There were 799,701 lb. fruit in Consumer Packages (including an estimate of 175,000 lb.) as compared with 454,076 lb. last month, while for re-processing purposes the total of all frozen fruits was 9,741,538 lb. including an estimate of 300 thousand lb. As imported fruits, including citrus fruits, are now included a comparison cannot be made with previous years, but the total for last month was 8,184,373 lb.

##### FRUIT IN PRESERVATIVES

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 17,002,867 lb. (including an estimate of 8 million lb.) as compared with 13.2 million lb. last month.

##### VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables at distributing centres only were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 1,976 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 3 thousand tons, as compared with a similar movement of 2.2 thousand tons last year.

Onion stocks were reported as 304 tons, as compared with 202 tons at the same date last year.

Celery. There were 1,454 crates of Canadian Celery and 114 crates of imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 56 tons; Cabbage 150 tons; Carrots 61 tons and Parsnips 2 tons. In addition there were imported stocks as follows: 1 ton Beets, 8 tons Cabbage; 3 tons Carrots and 450 tons Onions.

##### FROZEN VEGETABLES

The Consumer Packages classification showed a total of 1,427,489 lb. There were also 531,012 lb. for Re-processing purposes.

##### VEGETABLES IN BRINE

There were 145,913 lb. vegetables held in brine for Re-processing purposes.
