#### STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, APRIL 1, 1945

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, including holdings by commercial growers, were 38,362 barrels, 533,535 boxes and 236,123 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 885,554 bushels as compared with 621,611 bushels at April 1, 1944 and 2,042,270 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 1.2 million

bushels.

There were 319 bushels of Canadian and 2,251 bushels of imported pears in stock.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 239,612 lb, fruit in "Packages 10 lb, and under" while for bulk and containers "Over 101h" the total was 7,925,650 lb. including an estimate of 2,2 million lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 15,121,615 lb. (including an estimate of 6.5 million lb.)

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 23,286,877 1b. as compared with 28,585,172 lb. last year and 26,579,724 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian-grown vegetables, including holdings by Commercial growers were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 130,420 tons, there being an "Outof-Storage" movement of 67,000 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 8,432 tons, as compared with 838 tons at the same date last year, and 13,584 tons on March 1.

Celery. There were 544 crates of Canadian Celery on hand as compared with 937 last month and 68 crates last year. There were also 18,929 crates of imported on hand.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 400 tons; Carrots 2,303 tons; Cabbages 344 tons and Parsnips 393 tons.

In addition there were imported stocks on hand of 2 tons onions, 85 tons beets, 504 tons carrots and 657 tons cabbages.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages 10 lb, and under" showed a total of 280,177 lb. of which 90,000 lb. were estimated for late firms. There were also 1,066,332 lb. of bulk and "Over 10 lb.

There were 3,085,450 lb. vegetables held in brine.
