STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES, SEPT. 1, 1945

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, at distributing centres only, were 350 barrels, 5,906 boxes and 1,398 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 8,354 bushels as compared with 27,740 bushels at September 1, 1944 and 2,731 bushels last month. The apparent net "Into-Storage" movement was 5.6 thousand bushels.

PEARS

There were on hand 3,340 bushels of Canadian pears and 2,455 bushels of Imported.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 769,509 lb. fruit in "Packages 10 lb. and under" while for bulk and containers "Over 10 lb." the total was 7,766,896 lb. including an estimate of 260 thousand lb. for firms whose reports were late.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 13,676,181 lb. (including an estimate of 6 million lb.). A year ago they amounted to 21,459,090 lb. and last month to 18,235,276 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 22,211,586 lb. as compared with 32,417,728 lb. last year and 28,336,468 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing Centres only, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 969 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 314 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 647 tons, as compared with 557 tons at the same date last year, and 300 tons on August 1 this year.

Celery. There were 2,762 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 2,487 crates. On August 1, 1945 the stocks were 3,286 crates.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 74 tons; Carrots 289 tons and Cabbages 168 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages 10 lb. and under" showed a total of 848,636 lb. including an estimate of 300,000 lb. for firms whose reports were late. There were also 2,251,759 lb. in bulk and "Over 10 lb.".

There were 1,239,178 lb. vegetables held in brine.
