STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES JANUARY 1, 1946

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, including holdings by commercial growers, were 56,757 barrels,

1,492,229 boxes and 73,544 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 1,736,044 bushels as compared with 5,844,494 bushels at January 1, 1945 and 2,711,261 bushels last month. The apparent net "Outoff Storage" movement was 975,217 bushels.

PEARS

There were on hand 3,885 bushels of Canadian pears and 30,136 bushels of Imported.

There were 356,811 lb. fruit in "Packages under 10 lb." while for bulk and containers "10 lb. and over" the total

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in bengoate of soda totalled 15,369,016 lb. (including an estimate of 1,370,000 lb.). A year ago they amounted to 20,371,758 lb. and last month to 16,072,309 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 24,027,660 lb. as compared with 27,916,519 lb. last year and 26,260,285 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, including holdings by commercial growers, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 245,538 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 50,675 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 11,293 as compared with 20,023 tons at the same date last year and 13,632 tons on December 1, 1945.

Celery. There were 33,577 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 67,314 crates. On December 1, 1945, Canadian stocks were 138,818 crates. There were also 18,864 crates of Imported Celery.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 875 tons; Carrots 10,580 tons; Cabbages 4,704 tons and Parsnips 1,272 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 481,199 lb.
There were also 2,235,844 lb. in bulk and "Over 10 lb." and

1,987,443 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 592,000 lb. for firms whose reports were not received on time.
