APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, at distributing centres only were 40,890 barrels, 232,154 boxes and 593,444 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 866,488 bushels as compared with 278,000 bushels at November 1, 1945 and 331,697 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was 535 thousand bushels.

PEARS

There were 56,573 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand and 11,267 bushels of Imported Pears.

FRUIT FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 295,314 lb. of fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 13,593,369 lb. including an estimate of 370 thousand lb. for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 19,390,232 lb. (including an estimate of 3,700,000 lb.) A year ago they amounted to 18,567,605 lb. and last month to 20,993,372 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 30,278,915 lb. as compared with 29,618,908 lb. last year and 34,707,401 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only, were as follows:

POTATO holdings amounted to 30,693 tons, there being an into-storage movement of 27,253 tons.

ONION stocks were reported as 10,087 tons, as compared with 11,971 tons at the same date last year and 2,415 tons on October 1 of this year. There were also 98 tons of Imported stocks of Onions.

CELERY. There were 278,399 crates of Ganadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 196,619 crates. On October 1, Canadian stocks were 63,644 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 1,502 tons; carrots 8,267, cabbage 3,153 tons and paramips 1,489 tons:

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 778,392 lb. including an estimate of 256,000 lb. There were also 4,099,246 lb. "10 lb. and Over" and 1,939,037 lb. held in Brine.
