

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES APRIL 1, 1946

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, including holdings by commercial growers, were 624 barrels, 263,055 boxes and 14,044 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 278,971 bushels as compared with 885,554 bushels at April 1, 1945 and 581,725 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Storage" movement was 302 thousand bushels.

PEARS

There were on hand 2,255 bushels of Imported pears on April 1, 1946.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 120,170 lb. fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 6,548,807 lb. including an estimate of 604 thousand lb. for firms whose reports were late.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in bonzoate of soda totalled 11,564,765 lb. (including an estimate of 1,763,000 lb.). A year ago they amounted to 16,826,587 and last month to 12,437,083 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and preservatives, was 18,233,742 lb. as compared with 23,833,322 lb. last year and 19,908,745 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, including holdings by commercial growers, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 99,917 tons, there being an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 57 thousand tons. In addition there were imported stocks amounting to 11,509 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 2,952 tons, as compared with 8,432 tons at the same date last year and 5,452 tons on March 1, this year. There were also 4 tons of imported stocks.

Celery. There were 523 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 544 crates. On March 1, Canadian stocks were 1,740 crates. There were also 30,907 crates of Imported Celery on April 1, 1946.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 169 tons; Carrots 1,892 tons; Cabbages 42 tons and Parsnips 292 tons.
