Stocks of Fruit and Vegetables July 1, 1946

Ganadian apples held in Gold and Gommon Storage, at distributing APPLES. centres only were 19 barrels, 2901 boxes. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 2,958 bushels as compared with 6,433 bushels at July 1, 1945 and 12,574 bushels last month. The apparent net "Out-of-Sterage" movement was 10 thousand bushels.

PEARS

There were no pears on hand.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 131,997 lb. fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 7,176,140 ln. including an estimate of 220 thousand 1b. for firms whose reports were late.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 10,153,124 lb. (including an estimate of 2,000,000 lb.) A year ago they amounted to 12,488,141 and last month to 8,813,725 lb.

The total of all fruit, frezen and in preservatives, was 17,461,261 lb. as compared with 19,340,986 lb. last year and 12,948,729 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only, were as fellows:

Potato holdings amounted to 2,287 tons, there being an "Out-of Storage" movement of 9 thousand tons. In addition there were imported stocks amounting to 1,532 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 14 tens, as compared with 262 tens at the same date last year and 416 tens on June 1, this year. There were also 592 tens of imported stocks.

Celery. There were 2,377 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 2,047 crates. On June 1, Ganadian stocks were 415 crates. There were also 2,751 crates of imported colory on July 1, 1946.

Other Vegetables were reported as fellews: Beets 16 tens; carrots 54 tons, cabbages 178 tons and parsnips 27 tens.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 1b" showed a total of 307,078 lb. including an estimate of 17,000. There were also 937,892 lb. "10 lb. and Over" and 105,970 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 25,000.
