STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

SEPTEMBER 1, 1946

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, at distributing centres only were 830 barrels, 26,837 boxes and 18,952 "Other" bushels. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 48,279 bushels as compared with 8,354 bushels at September 1, 1945 and 9,142 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was 39 thousand bushels.

PEARS

There were 31,419 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand and 23,186 bushels of Imported Pears.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 321,770 lb. fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 12,217,791 lb. including an estimate of 431 thousand lb. for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 17,654,479 lb. (including an estimate of 2,931,000 lb.). A year ago they amounted to 17,787,947 and last month to 16,591,868 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 30,194,040 lb. as compared with 26,865,265 lb. last year and 28,274,214 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only, were as follows:

Potato holdings amounted to 1,766 tons, there being an "into-storage" movement of 257 tons. In addition there were imported stocks amounting to 44 tons.

Onion stocks were reported as 534 tons, as compared with 647 tons at the same date last year and 402 tons on August 1, this year.

Celery There were 5,237 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 2,762 crates. On August 1, Canadian stocks were 4,534 crates.

Other Vegetables were reported as follows: Beets 252 tons; carrots 316 tons, cabbages 390 tons and parsnips 36 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 682,489 lb. including an estimate of 192,000 lb. There were also 3,131,730 lb. "10 lb. and Over" and 1,912,864 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 39,000 lb.
