APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, at distributing centres only were 19,246 barrels, 254,631 boxes and 639,987 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 952,356 bushels as compared with 866,488 bushels as at November 1, 1946 and 200,254 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was 752 thousand bushels.

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - NOVEMBER 1, 1947

PEARS

There were 70,635 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand and 6,273 bushels of Imported Pears.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 361,115 pounds of fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 16,333,702 lb. including an estimate of 420,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoute of soda totalled 20,336,095 lb. (including an estimate of 3.4 million lb.) A year ago they amounted to 19,671,817 lb. and last month to 21,825,071 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 37,030,912 lb. as compared with 33,535,229 lb. last year and 38,141,697 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were as follows:

POTATO holdings amounted to 11,703 tons, there being an "into-storage" movement of 8,296 tons. There were also 24 tons of imported stocks.

ONION stocks were reported as 5,887 tons, as compared with 10,087 tons at the same date last year and 2,573 tons on October 1, 1947. There were also 2 tons of Imported Stocks.

CELERY There were 186,374 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 278,399 crates. On October 1, 1947 Canadian stocks were 97,664 crates. There were also imported stocks of Celery amounting to 452 crates on November 1.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 726 tons, Carrots 8,188 tons Cabbage 3,019 tons and Parsnips 478 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 962,637 lb., including an estimate of 400,000 lb., while for "10 lb. and over" the total was 5,681,964 lb., and 6,114,378 lb. held in Brine.
