## APPLES

Camdien apples held in Coid and Cormon Storage, at distributing centres only were 823,270 barrels, $3,026,397$ boxes and $1,001,851$ bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to buchels the combined figures were $6,498,358$ bushels as compared with 7,360,606 bushels as at December 1, 1946 and 952,356 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was: 5.5 million bushels.

There were 48,352 bushels of cunadisn Pears on hend and 6,026 bushels of 1 mported pears.

## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There we e 321,406 pounds of Fruit, in "Packages under $10 \mathrm{lb} . \mathrm{M}$, including an estimate of $30,000 \mathrm{lb}$. while for " 10 lb . and over" the total was $12,980,928 \mathrm{lb}$. including en estimate of $200,000 \mathrm{lb}$.for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $19,306,618 \mathrm{lb}$. $1_{\mathrm{n}}$ these figures an estimate of $4,000,000 \mathrm{lb}$. is included. A year ago they emounted to $18,406,408 \mathrm{lb}$. End last month to $19,613,655 \mathrm{lb}$.

The total of ell fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was z2,608,962 lb . as compared with $31,282,070 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $26,13 \pi, 1 \pi 6 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

    ON1ON stocks were reported as 15,902 tons, as compared with 18,040
    tons at the same dite-last year and 5,887 tons on November 1, 1947.
    CELERY There were 179,428 crates of Canndian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 274,514 crates. There were also imported stocks of Celery amounting to 2493 crates on December 1. On November 1, 1947 Canadian stocks were 186,374 crates. OTHER VEGFTABLES were reported as follows: Beets $17 \AA 2$ tons, Carrots 9725 tons Cabbage 4,559 tons and Parsnips 1041 tons.
