### STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES--AUGUST 1, 1947

#### APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common storage, at distributing centres only, were 553 barrels, 10,213 boxes and 1,695 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 13,567 bushels as compared with 9,142 bushels at August 1, 1946 and 15,206 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-Storage" movement was 1.6 thousand bushels.

There were also 6,023 bushels of Imported Apples on hand on August 1, 1947.

#### PEARS

There were 275 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand and 16,807 bushels of Imported Pears.

#### FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 222,836 lb. of fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 15,931,270 lb. including an estimate of 1,500,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 20,520,341 lb. (including an estimate of 8,000,000 lb.) A year ago they amounted to 18,058,325 lb. and last month to 14,841,648 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 36,674,447 pounds as compared with 29,773,372 lb. last year and 25,912 434 lb. last month.

#### VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were as follows:

POTATO holdings amounted to 3,596 tons, there being an "out-of-storage" movement of 2.6 thousand tons. Stocks of imported potatoes were 4 tons.

ONION stocks were reported as 517 tons, as compared with 402 tons at the same date last year and 403 tons on July 1, 1947. There were also 177 tons of Imported Stocks.

CELERY There were 4,512 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 4,534 crates. On July 1, 1947 Canadian stocks were 2,057 crates. There were also 195 crates of Imported Stocks of Celery on August 1, 1947.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 104 tons, Carrots 443 tons, Cabbage 139 tons and Parsnips 2 tons Canadian and Imported stocks as: Beets 18 tons, Carrots 47 tons and Cabbage 5 tons.

#### VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 502,041 lb. while for "10 lb. and over" the total was 2,663,799 lb. and 1,220,976 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 75,000 lb.

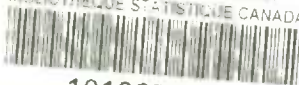
