STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - OCTOBER 1, 1948

APPLES Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, at distributing centres only were 2,384 barrels, 85,940 boxes and 119,138 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 212,230 bushels as compared with 200,254 bushels as at October 1, 1947 and 14,504 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was 197,726 bushels.

There were 54,929 bushels of Pears on hand as compared with 73,467 bushels on October 1, 1947.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 506,053 lb. of Fruit, in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 19,544,598 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 22,609,028 lb. A year ago they amounted to 22,001,605 lb. and last month to 21,754,994 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 42,659,679 lb. as compared with 38,495,691 lb. last year and 42,220,148 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were:

POTATO: Stocks of potatoes were 2,538 tons, there being an "into-storage" movement of 848 tons.

ONION Onion holdings were reported as 4,730 tons as compared with 2,573 tons last year and 814 tons last month.

CELERY There were 108,347 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at October 1, there were 97,664 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 115 tons, Carrots 393 tons, Cabbage 162 tons and Parsnips 53 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages Under 10 lb." showed a total of 1,335,754 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 5,750,281 lb. There were 5,004,218 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 200,000 lb.
