STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - FEBRUARY 1, 1948

APPLES

Canadian apples held in Cold and Common Storage, at distributing centres only were 267,246 barrels, 1,999,426 boxes and 614,587 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 3,415,751 bushels as compared with 2,191,750 bushels as at February 1, 1947 and 4,910.850 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 1.5 million bushels.

PEARS

There were 16,873 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand and 2077 bushels of Imported Pears.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 392,544 pounds of Fruit, in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was ll,110,495 lb. including an estimate of 400,000 lb. for firms failing to report on time.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 16,255,543 lb. In these figures an estimate of 1,500,000 lb. is included. A year ago they amounted to 17,493,466 lb. and last month to 16,089,523 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 27,758,582 lb. as compared with 28,936,205 lb. last year and 28,370,078 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were as follows:

<u>POTATO</u> holdings amounted to 316,588 tons, there being an "outof-storage" movement of 62,078 tons. There were also 250 tons of Imported Potatoes.

ONIONS Stocks of onions were reported as 8,200 tons as compared with 11,671 tons at the same date last year and 13,228 tons on January 1, 1948.

<u>CELERY</u> There were 2,770 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at the same date there were 18,690 crates. There were also imported stocks of Celery amounting to 14,336 crates on February 1, 1947. On January 1, 1948 Canadian stocks were 53,489 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 845 tons, Carrots 4157 tons Cabbage 460 tons and Parsnips 474 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 Ib." showed a total of 575,449 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 6,511,800 lb. including an estimate of 200,000 lb. There were 5,483,480 lb. held in Brine, including an estimate of 500,000 lb.
