## APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, includins holdines by comnarcial prowars were 2,401 barrels, 242,333 boxss and 25,459 bushels in other containers. Convertine all containers to bushels the combined fimuros were 274,995 bushels as compared with $62,37 ?$ bushels as at June 1, 1347 and 587,743 bushels lass month. The apparent net "out-oi-storage" movement was 312.7 thousand bushels.

FEARS There were no Canadian or Imported Pears on hand on June 1, 1948.
FRUIT, FROZZN AND IN TRESERVATIVSS
There were 296,416 pounds of Fruit, in "Packages Under 10 lb ." while for "lo lb . and Dvar" the total was $6,268,745 \mathrm{lb}$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur zioxite or in benzoate of soda totalled $16,120,105$ pounds. In these firures an estimate of $400,000 \mathrm{lb}$. is included. A year aco thoy anounted to $12,097,463 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to $17,518,963$ pounds.

The total of all fruit, froen and in preservatives, was 22,685,266 16 , as compared with $18,139,651 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $25,909,962 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

VEGETABLES
Holding of Canadian rown vegetables, incluaing holdings hy commarcial rrowers were as follows:
