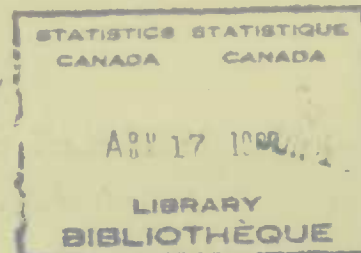

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - JUNE 1, 1948

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, including holdings by commercial growers were 2,401 barrels, 242,333 boxes and 25,459 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 274,995 bushels as compared with 62,377 bushels as at June 1, 1947 and 587,743 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 312.7 thousand bushels.

PEARS There were no Canadian or Imported Pears on hand on June 1, 1948.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 296,416 pounds of Fruit, in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 6,268,745 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 16,120,105 pounds. In these figures an estimate of 400,000 lb. is included. A year ago they amounted to 12,097,463 lb. and last month to 17,518,963 pounds.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 22,685,266 lb. as compared with 18,139,651 lb. last year and 25,909,962 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, including holdings by commercial growers were as follows:

POTATO holdings amounted to 51,335 tons, there being an "out-of-storage" movement of 52,103 tons.

ONION-stocks of onions were reported as 835 tons as compared with 632 tons at the same date last year and 469 tons last month.

CELERY There were no crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at June 1 there were 2,548 crates. There were also imported stocks of celery amounting to 9,807 crates on June 1, 1947.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows:

Beets 19 tons, Carrots 193 tons Cabbage 387 tons and  
Parsnips 17 tons.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 297,529 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 2,802,468 lb. There were 3,627,971 pounds held in brine.
