

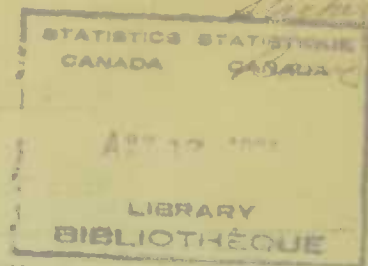

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - JULY 1, 1948

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, at distributing centres only were 86 barrels, 91,489 boxes and 1,846 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 93,593 bushels as compared with 15,206 bushels as at July 1, 1947 and 274,995 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 181 thousand bushels.

APPLES There were 3,395 bushels of Imported Apples on hand on July 1, 1948.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 261,927 lb. of Fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 11,870,308 lb.

The stocks of Fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 14,973,060 lb. In these figures an estimate of 6,400,000 lb. is included. A year ago they amounted to 14,910,608 lb. and last month to 15,858,665 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 27,105,295 lb. as compared with 26,161,384 lb. last year and 22,424,201 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were:

POTATO holdings amounted to 4,003 tons, there being an "out-of-storage" movement of 47,332 tons.

ONION stocks were reported as 267 tons as compared with 403 tons at the same date last year and 835 tons last month.

CELERY There were 5,375 crates of Canadian celery on hand. Last year at July 1 there were 2,057 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows:

Beets 7 tons, Carrots 435 tons, Cabbage 185 tons. There were no Parsnips on hand on July 1.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages under 10 lb." showed a total of 396,915 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 2,635,391 lb. There were 3,070,617 lb. held in brine.
