STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGATABLES - AUGUST 1, 1948

APPLES Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, at distributing centres only were 81 barrels, 14,265 boxes and 875 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 15,383 bushels as compared with 13,567 bushels as at August 1, 1947 and 93,593 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 78 thousand bushels. There were no Imported Apples on hand on August 1.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 319,583 lb. of Fruit in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 20,490,395 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 21,263,264 b. A year ago they amounted to 19,568,264 b. and last month to 16,142,989 b.

The total of all fruit, frozon and in preservatives, was 42,073,242 lb. as compared with 35,641,649 lb. last year and 28,873,775 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables, at distributing centres only were:

POTATO holdings amounted to 1,843 tons, there being an "out-of-storage" movement of 2,160 tons.

ONION stocks were reported as 269 tons as compared with 517 tons last year and 267 tons last month.

DETERY There were 3,363 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at August 1 there were 4,512 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 85 tons, Carrots 169 tons, Cabbage 191 tons and Parsnips 134 tons.

VECTABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages Under 10 lb." showed a total of 834,885 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 3,924,265 lb. There were 2,863,041 lb. held in brine, including an estimate of 125,000 lb.
