STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - SEPTEMBER 1, 1948

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage, at distributing centres only were 164 barrels, 9,756 boxes and 4,256 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 14,504 bushels as compared with 26,897 bushels as at September 1, 1947 and 15,383 bushels last month. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 879 bushels.

There were 7,291 bushels of Pears on hand as compared with 14,816 bushels on September 1, 1947.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 459,205 lb. of Fruit, in "Packages Under 10 lb." while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 19,652,354 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 22,079,662 lb. A year ago they amounted to 20,918,235 lb. and last month to 21,031,631 lb.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives, was 42,191,221 lb. as compared with 37,484,823 lb. last year and 41,254,552 lb. last month.

POTATO Stocks of potatoes were 1,690 tons, there being an "out-of-storage movement of 153 tons.

ONION Onion holdings were reported as 814 tons as compared with 676 tons last year and 269 tons last month. There were also 51 tons of Imported Onions on hand on September 1, 1948.

CELERY There were 3,165 crates of Canadian Celery on hand. Last year at September 1, there were 13,256 crates.

OTHER VEGETABLES were reported as follows: Beets 96 tons, Carrots, 250 tons Cabbage 172 tons and Parsnips 10 tons. There were 76 tons of Imported carrots on hand on September 1, 1948.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Packages Under 10 lb." showed a total of 1,245,227 lb. while for "10 lb. and Over" the total was 5,325,845 lb. There were 4,008,313 lb. held in Brine.
