## APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 677,288 barrels, $4,996,045$ boxes and 1,891,707 bushels in other containers. Converting all containers to bushels the comoined figure was $8,919,616$ bushels as compared with $5,129,432$ bushels as at December 2,1948 and 969,958 bushels last month. The apparent net "into-storage" movement was 7,949,658 bushels.

PEARS There were 43,843 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand December 1, 1949.

## FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN FRESGRVATIVSS

There were 394,000 lb . of" fruit in "Containers 1 lb 。 and Under" while for 'Over 1 1b." the total was $15,493,0001 \mathrm{~b}$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $14,886,0001 \mathrm{~b}$. A year ago they amounted to $21,455,00 \mathrm{C} 1 \mathrm{~b}$ 。 and last month to 15,940,000 1b.

The total of all fruit, frozen and in presorvatives, was $30,778,000$ 1b. as compared with $38,270,000 \mathrm{lb}$, last year and $33,099,00 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

## VEGuTABLSS

Holdings or Canadian frown vegetablas were:
POTATO Stocks of potatoes were 686,582 tons, there beine an "into-storage" movement of 657,196 tons. There were also 139 tons of importad potatoes on hand December 1, 1949.

ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 16,778 tons as compared with 22,779 tons 1 ast year and 15,956 tons last month. There wore also 86 tons of imported onions on hand on Decemtor $1,1949$.

CJIERY There were 351,015 crates of Sanadian celery on hand Last year at Decenber 1 there were 197,735 arates on hand. There were 3,032 crates of imported celery on hand on December $1,1949$.

OTHER VEGETABLES were repor ted as follows: Beets 2,589 tons, Cumpots 13,566 tons, cabbsge 8,271 tons and rarsnips 2,298 tons.
