APples Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 368 barrels， 13,602 boxes and 10,505 bushels in other containers．Converting all containers to bushels the combined figures were 25,211 bushels as compared with 14，504 bushels as at September 1，1948，and 9，073 bushels last month．＂The apparent net＂into－ storage＂movement was 16,138 bushels．

PEARS There were 34,417 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand September $1,1949$.

## FRUIT，FROZEN AND IN PRES ERVARIVES

There were $445,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．of fruit in＂Containers 1 lb ．and $u_{n d e}$＂while for＂Over 110.0 ，the tote 1 was $15,188,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in berzote of soda totalled $14,597,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．A year ago they amounted to $21,960,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．and last month to $15,676,0001 \mathrm{~b}$ ．

The total of all fruit，frozen and in preservatives，was 32，278，000 lb ． as compared with $42,492,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。 last year and $32,450,000 \mathrm{lb}$ ．last month．

## VEGETABLES

Holdings of Canadian grown vegetables were：
POTATO Stocks of potatoes were 2，032 tons，there being an＂out－of－star age＂ movement of 579 tons．

QNION Stocks of onions were reported as 574 tons as compare with 814 tons last year and 382 tons 1 last month．There were al so 33 tons of imported on ions on hand on September 1， 1949.

CBLERY There wore 6,720 crates of Canadian celery on hand．Last year at September 1 there were 3,615 crates on hand．There wore no stocks of imported celery on hand on September $1,1919$.

Mali VEGRMBLAS were reported as follows：Boots 118 tons，Carrots 177 tons， Cabbage 106 tons and Parsnips 8 tons．Imported stocks were：Carrots 16 tons and Cabbage 1 ton．
