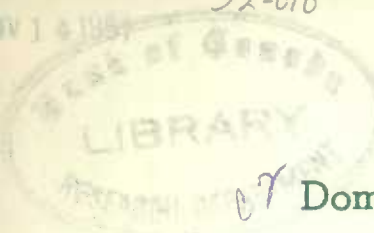

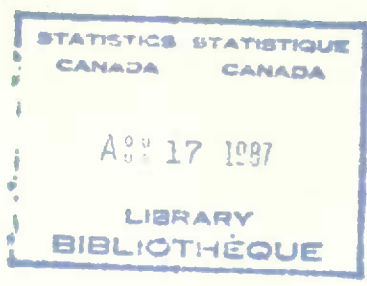

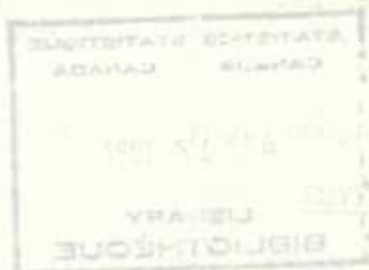

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - NOVEMBER 1, 1951

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 7,100,000 bushels, as compared with 8,837,000 bushels last year.

PEARS

There were 164,000 bushels of Pears on hand on November 1, 1951.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 2,655,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 20,913,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 14,655,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 14,649,000 lb. and last month to 14,940,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 38,223,000 lb. as compared with 32,730,000 lb. last year and 39,634,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:

POTATO

Stocks of potatoes were 15,941,000 bushels, as compared with 24,501,000 bushels last year.

ONION

Stocks of onions were reported as 800,000 bushels as compared with 1,290,000 bushels last year.

CARROTS

Stocks of carrots amounted to 715,000 bushels as compared with 498,000 bushels last year.

CABBAGE

Stocks of cabbages decreased to 346,000 bushels from 400,000 bushels last year.

CELERY

There were 326,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at November 1 there were 353,000 crates.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 2,668,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 11,490,000 lb. There were 4,085,000 lb. held "In Brine".
