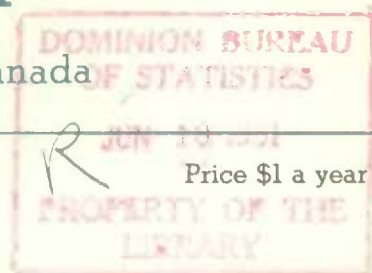

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - JUNE 1, 1951

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 267,000 bushels compared with 857,000 bushels last month and 144,000 bushels last year. The apparent net "out-of-storage" movement was 590,000 bushels.

PEARS

There were 1,000 bushels of Canadian Pears on hand on June 1, 1951

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 915,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under". while for "Over 1 lb.". the total was 9,905,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 11,727,000 lb. A Year ago they amounted to 10,292,000 lb. and last month to 13,445,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 22,547,000 lb. as compared with 17,393,000 lb. last year and 24,416,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:

POTATO

Stocks of potatoes were 3,407,000 bushels, there being an "out-of-storage" movement of 3,209,000 bushels.

ONION

Stocks of onions were reported as 105,000 bushels as compared with 51,000 bushels last year and 203,000 bushels last month.

CARROTS

Stocks of carrots amounted to 33,000 bushels as compared with 106,000 bushels last month and 55,000 bushels last year.

CABBAGE

Stocks of cabbages were 25,000 bushels.

CELERY

There were 11,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at June 1, there were 14,000 crates.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 1,693,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 4,865,000 lb. There were 1,350,000 lb. held "In Brine".

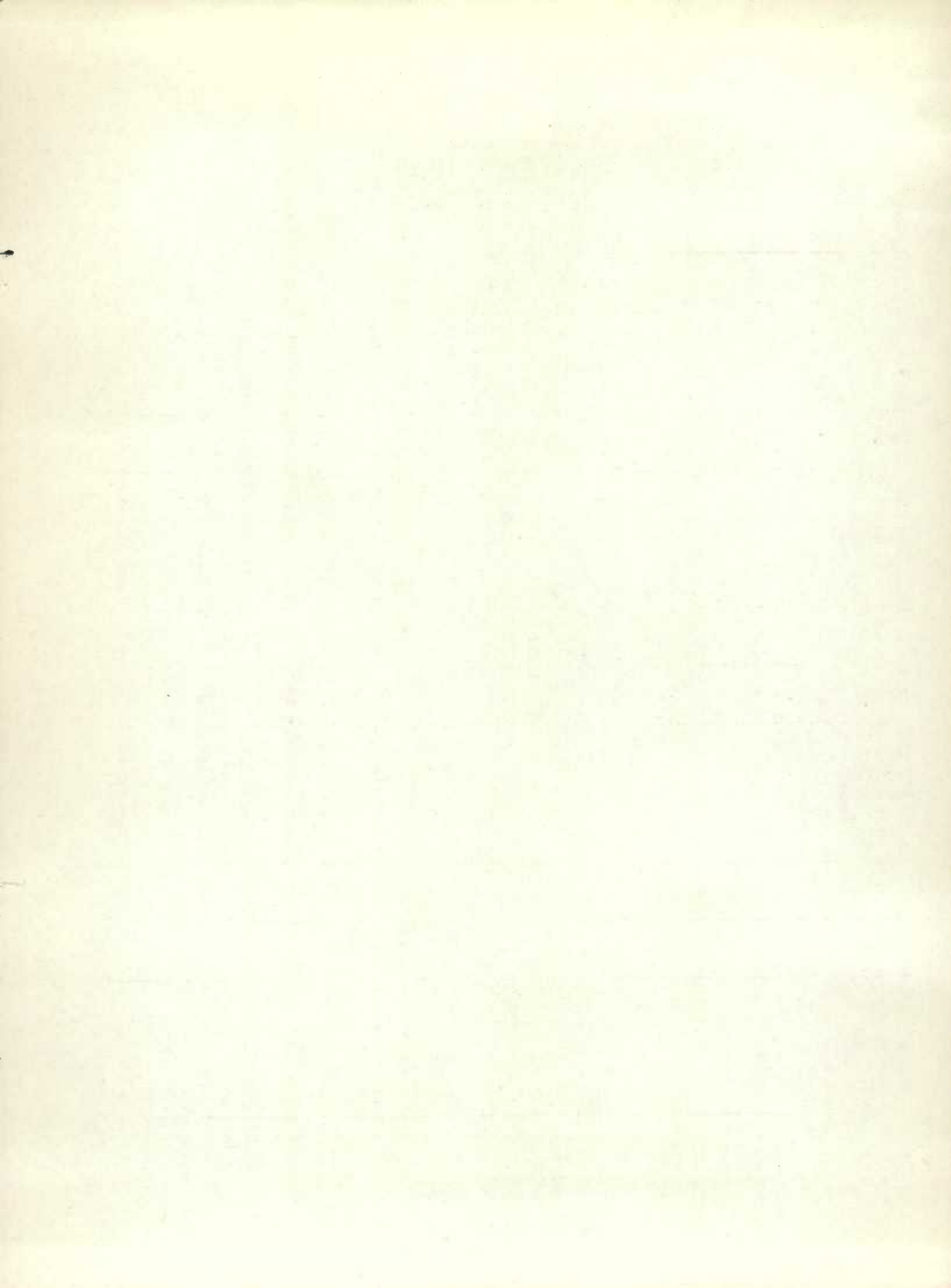
