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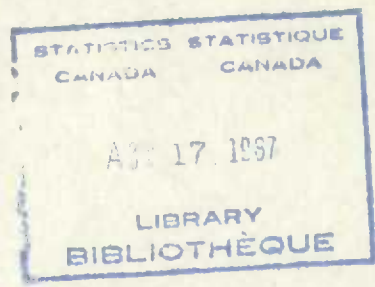

STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - JANUARY 1, 1952

APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 3,856,000 bushels, compared with 6,101,000 bushels last year.

PEARS

There were 63,000 bushels of Pears on hand on January 1, 1952.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 1,892,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 19,985,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 14,062,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 16,496,000 lb. and last month to 14,284,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 35,939,000 lb. as compared with 33,041,000 lb. last year and 38,166,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:

POTATO

Stocks of potatoes were 11,812,000 bushels, as compared with 19,494,000 bushels last year.

ONION

Stocks of onions were reported as 426,000 bushels as compared with 999,000 bushels last year.

CARROTS

Stocks of carrots amounted to 473,000 bushels as compared with 530,000 bushels last year.

CABBAGE

Stocks of cabbages decreased to 176,000 bushels from 260,000 bushels last year.

CELERY

There were 56,000 crates of celery on hand. Last year at January 1 there were 56,000 crates.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 3,039,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 10,342,000 lb. There were 3,295,000 lb. held "In Brine."

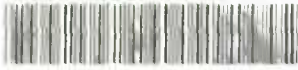
