## SOURCE AND CONTENT

The figures submitted herewith represent stocks of fruit and vegetables; fresh, frozen and in preservatives, held by food processors, cold storages, frult warehouses, wholesalers and in farm storages of comercial growers.

Inventories of fresh fruit and vegetables are obtained through the inspection services of the Department of Agriculture. Stocks of fruit and vegetables, frozen and in preservatives are obtained by mail questionnaire.

## APPLPE

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 4,941,000 bushels, compared with 5,282,000 bushels last year.

## FEARS

I'here were 51,000 bushels of Pears on hand on December 1. 1952. FRUIT FROZEN AND IN PRRSERVATIVES

There were 2.033.000 lb 。 of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Under" while for "Over 12 b 。" the total was $15,021,000 \mathrm{lb}$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 11,572,000 1b. A year ago they amounted to $14,320,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to 11,862,000 1b. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was $28,626,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $38,322,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $30,056,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

## VEGETABLAS

Holdings of vegetables were:
POTATO Stocks of potatoes were 17,719,000 bushels, as compared with 13: 941,000 bushels last year.

ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 820.000 bushels as compared with 570.000 bushels last year,

CARROTS Stocks or carrots amounted to 893.000 bushels as compared with 666.000 bushels last year.

CABBAGE Stocks of cabbages increased to 311,000 bushels from 309,000 bustiels last year.

GELFRY There were 128,000 crates of selery on hand. Last year at December I there were 184.000 crates.

VEGETALBES FTKOZFN AND IN BRINE
"Containers 1 lb, and Under" showed a total of 3,816,000 lb, while for "Over l lb." the total was 6,900,000 1b. There were 6,621,000 lb. held "In Brine."
