## STOCKS OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES - FEBRUARY 1, 1952

## APPLES

Canadian apples held in cold and common storage were 2,578,000 bushels, compared with 4,511,000 bushels last year.

## PEARS

There were 33,000 bushels of pears on hand on February $1,1952$.

## FRUIT, FRUZEN AND IN FRESERVATIVES

There were 2,770,000 lb . of fruit in "Containers 1 lb . and Under" while for "Over 1 lb ." the total was $18,150,00 \mathrm{lb}$.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $13,620,000 \mathrm{lb}$. A year ago they amounted to $16,364,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to $13,898,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was $34,540,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $31,216,000 \mathrm{lb}$ 。 last year and $35,597,000$ lb. last month.

## VEGETABLES

Holdings of vegetables were:
POrA'r Stocks of potatoes were $9,395,000$ bushels, as compared with 16,383,000 bushels last year.

ONION Stocks of onions were reported as 230,000 bushels as compared with 735,000 bushels last yoar.

CARROTS Stocks of carrots amounted to 355,000 bushety as cempared with 389,00C bushels last year.

CABBAGE Stocks of cabbages decreased to 94,000 bushels from 149,000 bushels last year.

OELBRY There were 32,000 crates of celery on hand. last yoar at february 1 there were 22,000 crates.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE
"Containers 1 lb . and Under" showed a total of 2,617,000 lb. while for "Over $1 \mathrm{lb."} \mathrm{the} \mathrm{total} \mathrm{was} \mathrm{8,42l,000} \mathrm{lb}$. were 3,044,000 lbe held "In Brine."
