The figures submitted herewith represent stocks of fruit and vegetables; frozen and in preservatives, held by food processors and cold storage warehouses.

Stocks of fresh fruit and vegetables are reported only during the storage period, November 1 to June 1 inclusive.


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## FRUIT, FROZAN AND IN ERESERVATIVES

There were 1,474,000 1b, of fruit in Containers 1 1b. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 13,074,000 1b.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled $9,525,000 \mathrm{lb}$. A year ago they amounted to $10,893,000 \mathrm{lb}$. and last month to $10,175,000 \mathrm{lb}$. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was $24,073,000 \mathrm{lb}$. as compared with $26,612,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last year and $22,405,000 \mathrm{lb}$. last month.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE
"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 988,000 1b. while for "Over 1 2b." the total was 3,635,000 1b. There were 504,000 10. held "In Brine."
