Stocks of fresh fruit and vegetables are reported only during the storage period, November 1 to June 1 inclusive.

FRUIT, FROZEN AND IN PRESERVATIVES

There were 2,895,000 lb. of fruit in "Containers 1 lb. and Under" while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 18,886,000 lb.

The stocks of fruit in sulphur dioxide or in benzoate of soda totalled 9,993,000 lb. A year ago they amounted to 12,757,000 lb. and last month to 10,618,000 lb. The total of all fruit, frozen and in preservatives was 31,774,000 lb. as compared with 36,799,000 lb. last year and 31,693,000 lb. last month.

VEGETABLES, FROZEN AND IN BRINE

"Containers 1 lb. and Under" showed a total of 3,018,000 lb. while for "Over 1 lb." the total was 5,179,000 lb. There were 5,261,000 lb. held "In Brine."
